DOG SHOW FAMILY DEFINITIONS

- ANGULATION** - Refers to what any normal husband would rather be doing at 5:00am. (My own personal preference is catfish, but whatever's biting will do).
- SABERLIKE TAIL** - Refers to the shape of the tail - it should resemble an outside curveball thrown by Brett Saberhagen.
- EVEN BITE** - One bite and all your fingers will be an even length - GONE!!!
- GOOD PIGMENT** - Analagous to "Your blind date has a great personality".
- DEEP CHESTED** - A dog with a low bark - the kind you would expect to meet at a jazz festival.
- EXTREME** - Refers to a far reach; such as my excuse to miss the dog show (see angulation).
- HANDLER** - Person who run around with a dog inside the ring making a fool of himself. Requirements: (1) Dog, (2) Dress clothes, (3) Knowledge of Show ring. The last two requirements are optional.
- PROFESSIONAL HANDLER** - Person who makes his living as a handler (see above). Requirements: (1) Paying client. All other requirements are purely optional.
- DOUBLE HANDLING** - Avoidance of making a fool of yourself in the ring by doing it outside the ring. This is illegal and is never done intentionally. (My yelling "Here Doggie Doggie" when the judge was looking at my dog was purely accidental).
