






THE GROOMING TABLE

DOES YOUR PET HAVE DRY SKIN?????

Low humidity is one reason your pet may have dry skin. In my quest for the perfect "show coat", I have been given many suggestions. Here are a few:


- Mix one capful of Alpha-Keri Bath Oil (other kinds of oil will probably work just as well and not cost as much) with one pint of water and spray the mixture onto your pet's coat with a plant mister.
- Mix Vaseline Intensive Care Lotion (once again, some other brand will probably work as well) half and half with water and spray onto your pet's coat.
- 3. Mix one capful of Aloe Vera juice or gel (or a couple of leaves from a plant) with a pint of water and spray onto your pet's coat.

 NOTE: Only make as much of this mixture as you will use in one day, as it will spoil and smell bad if it sits for very long!
- 4. There are also many fine commercial coat care products on the market. Some of them include mink oil, various combinations of protein and other additives, and coat conditioners for after bathing.

If your pet does not like being sprayed, you can also sponge the mixture onto his coat. Which ever treatment you choose, it should be done as needed. Some animals may need to be treated daily to keep their skin moisturized, while others can get by with weekly or bimonthly treatments.

Emergencies

How To Treat Common Emergencies

In all cases listed below, except where noted, be sure to take your dog to the veterinarian immediately after you've treated him.

Allergic reaction: For insect bites or other allergens, symptoms include runny eyes, sneezing, severe itch, swelling of eyes and face, and unconsciousness. Remove insect sting with tweezers.

Burns, **chemical**: Flush skin with water for 10 to 15 minutes. Treat internal burns as poisoning.

Burns, other: Because the risk of infection is high, do *not* apply anything to burns. Cover the burn with a clean cloth (other than cotton) and rush the dog to your veterinarian for treatment.

Choking: Push lower jaw open, and tilt head up. Using extreme caution, try to remove object with fingers. If unsuccessful, kneel behind dog, holding his body just below the ribs. Squeeze hard a few times, pressing up. If object does not pop out, rush to veterinarian.

Drowning: Hold dog upside down for 10 to 15 seconds. Give artificial respiration, and also CPR if there's no heartbeat. Wrap warmly.

Electric shock: Knock electrical cord out of socket with wooden object. Give CPR and or artificial respiration. Keep animal warm.

Fractures: Restrict movement. Do not attempt to set the bone. If far from veterinarian, wrap limb with cotton, splint front legs or upper back legs with a stick, rolled newspaper, or similar object. Wrap loosely with gauze.

Heatstroke, beat prostration:

Caused by high heat and humidity and inadequate water and ventilation. Symptoms are panting, high fever (105 to 10⁻¹ degrees Fahrenheit), and collapse. Lower body temperature by hosing or immersing dog in cool water up to neck for 10 minutes. Apply ice pack to head. Take to veterinarian when temperature begins to decline.

Swallowed objects: If dog has swallowed soft objects (such as those made of rubber) or hard and smooth small objects (such as marbles), induce vomiting. Do not induce vomiting of sharp objects.

Preparation: Ask Your Veterinarian

Your emergency preparations won't be complete unless you discuss them with your veterinarian.

Dr. Jerry McGraw, owner and administrator of two Chicago-area pet emergency clinics, recommends that you "try to anticipate these things. Talk to your veterinarian first. Ask. 'What would you like me to do in case of an emergency?"

You may want to ask these questions as well: Can you call your veterinarian in the middle of the night and expect him to meet you at the clinic? Will he make house calls? Is there a local pet emergency clinic? Where? What are its hours? Is it open on holidays and weekends? Does your community have a poison-control center or hotline?

If a crisis arises before you have recorded emergency information, call an operator for assistance or check the veterinarians' listings in the Yellow Pages of your telephone book.
