I REMEMBER BEAR

What can I say about a dog whose registered name was "Just Plain Bear"?

This dog was given to me by Don and Helene Bridges about two years ago to keep until we could find him a home. She knew I loved black shepherds, so she knew I would take him. The man who had owned him was changing jobs and would be traveling and unable to care for him.

We found him a home right away, but the lady changed her mind and brought him home. Then another family wanted him, but they decided they would rather have a puppy. By this time, Bear had already decided this was where he wanted to live and I had already let move into my heart, as well as my home.

As it turned out, Bear was a monorchid, so I had him neutered. Then I had him x-rayed and found out he was severely dysplastic in both hips and in both elbows. Apparently, he had spent most of the first four years of his life on a chain in a backyard. My vet said he could operate, but didn't think it would do much good, since he was almost five years old. Since he appeared to not be in pain, I kept him. He also had a severe ear infection in both ears, so I had to clear that problem up. He also looked like a graduate of a prisoner of war camp. He was severely underweight and it took a while to get him up to where he belonged for his size.

He was a big old bear. He could win anyone over in no time at all. He loved everyone, and thrived on the attention he got.

On Saturday, April 15, 1989, his trail had to come to an end. His one elbow had become so arthritic that he could barely use the leg at all and was now in pain. Medication had not helped and x-rays showed that surgery was definitely not recommended.

Bear was always very vocal about everything. I can still see Holly running the fence with the dog next door. When I would call her and she refused to stop, Bear would go out and bark at her. Although, he couldn't chase her, he would stand there, wait for her to pass, and grab her by the back of the neck and hold her till I got there.

I remember Gypsy giving him kisses, much to his dismay, until she almost had her whole head in his mouth.

I remember his distinctive scratch on the door, the way he held on to your hand or foot with his paws to make sure you didn't go away.

Most of all, I remember his beautiful dark brown eyes that shone with love.

My thanks to Don and Helene for two years of love from Bear and to Marcia for helping me to get through the end.

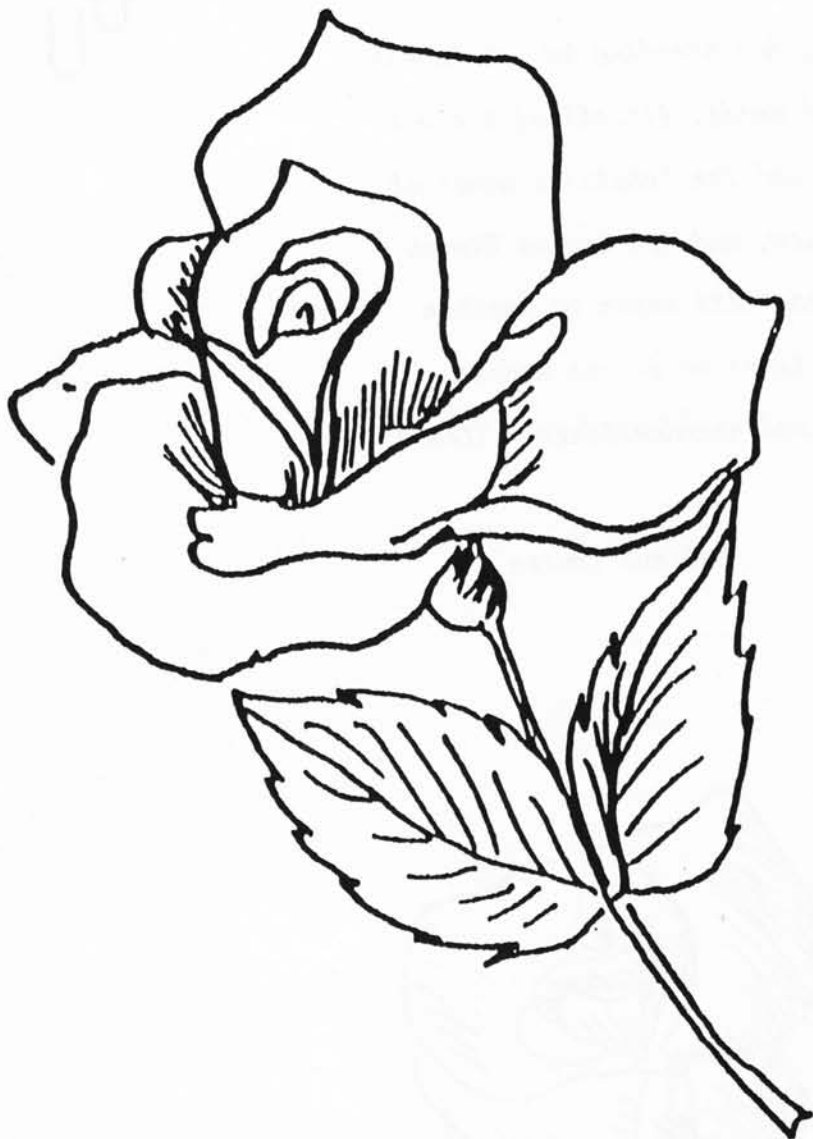
