I knew it was comming, but still the Autumn crept up on padded cat's paws. I awoke one cool crisp morning to find the summer ended.



The President of the SV and WUSV, Mr. Hermann Martin, underlined the fact that the SV and the Law Enforcement agencies of the Federal Republic of Germany using German Shepherd Dogs as Service Cooperate very successfully. He mentioned that the benefits are obvious for both sides. He pledged that in view of the traditional cooperation the SV would continue efforts to assist all agencies.—even in foreign countries — using or planning to use German Shepherd Dogs.

Both trials are held at the same time and in the same location demonstrating a unique testimonial of cooperation between the Breed Club in Germany and Law Enforcement Agencies.

The show was held at the Olympic Equestrian Center München-Riem. Weather conditions were excellent and permitted equal performances. The Show was conducted by the SV Landgroup Bayern (Bavaria) under its President Mr. Gerard Hörth.

He thanked all participants and expressed his admiration for the foreign guests — as he called them. He recognized the difficulties which these handlers coming from far away have to cope with. He also mentioned the fact that especially handlers coming from other continents have only a short time to acclimate. Mr. Hörth said that is is indeed remarkable that these handlers from uproad don't get discouraged and still come every year. He closed by praising the outstanding sportsmanship and fairness of all handlers.

Of the 79 Service Dogs entered, 16 came from outside West Germany. The German Police had 11 teams in the Trial. Belgium, Luxemburg, France, the United States of America and even Japan had sent their teams also.

The 1987 Champion was Police Officer Hans-Joachim Bock (State Police Hessen) with his Service Dog Lido vom Gleenbachtal. He earned a total of 294 out of 300 possible and was rated Excellent. His individual scores were: A (Tracking) 99 points; B (Obedience) 99 points; C (Protection) 96 points.

A close second was Police Officer Paul Hörmann (State Police Bayern) with his German Shepherd Dog Andy von der Bildsäule.

The overall performance list showed: V U 34 23 9 5 4 Α B 23 32 24 19 15 24 18

The team of the State Police Bavaria won the TEAM COMPETITION. The individual handlers of the team placed second, fourth, sixth, eighteenth and eleventh.

4 Police Officers from the United States participated in this International Competition. They placed 50, 52, 62, and 72. I am not familiar with the US Participants and the selection process.

It was stated in the official publication of the SV that a surprisingly high number of Service Dogs (18) exhibited dis-satisfactory Protection or Attack work. It has to be mentioned at this point that the requirements for Service Dogs are even more demanding and difficult than those for Schutzhund III.

At the end of the Championship trial and before the Victors were honored the excellent band of the Bavarian State Police entertained the spectators. The Police Equestrian Team demonstrated and the highlight was the arrival of a helicopter carrying Service Dogs and when close to the ground jumped out and into action.

### I Get So Much Help By Nancy Yadon Kearney

Onyx goes out of her way to be a big help to me. I don't know how I ever got any work done before she came to live with me.

Getting the sheets off the bed is a job in which she takes great delight. She helps by taking the corners with me as I lift them off. Putting on the clean sheets is one of her favorite times to lend a paw. Actually, she lends four of them, standing in the middle of the bed and trying to catch the sheet as I try to put it in the bed. Naturally, she also carries her share down to the washer by taking hold of whatever hangs down. Pillow cases are fun too, trying to help tug them on the pillow just like I do, only she isn't as careful. How I ever made a bed or changed sheets without her indispensable help is beyond me. But no matter how much I insist that she need not bother to help, she is right there in the middle, doing her part to make the job go along.

Fixing a meal goes so much better with a black nose constantly appearing at your elbow. Again, I send her on her way, but two seconds later she is back grimning, willing to share the work, especially tasting, in spite of my protests. Getting a meal on the table is an adventure since she started to help. She'd help clean dishes willingly, but I don't want to put a strain on her.

At first when I used the vacuum, Onyx just avoided it. Lately, however, she has decided to check to make sure it is really picking up the dirt. She stands directly in front of the vacuum and backs up one step at a time as it comes forward, wagging her tail and laughing. It takes more time now to run the vacuum, but I'm sure the fact that it stays in one spot longer means it is picking up more.

Dusting, which I don't do very often, is another place where she has decided her sharp eyes are needed to insure a good job. That black nose is right in the middle of whatever I'm trying to wipe off. She even tries to take the dust cloth and touch up where she thinks I've missed.

Any kind of sewing requires her attention. She puts her head in my lap to hold the piece steady and checks to make sure the button is on tight, or that the stitches are nice and even.

One evening she got annoyed with the bill paying chore. She kept trying to take the pen from my hand. I told her the bank wouldn't accept her signature and she got so piqued that when I left for a moment to answer the telephone, she ran off with the pen and chewed it up.

Her newest chore is shaking out the throw rug by the front door. My carpet is red and I managed to find a red throw rug just by luck. The thing is so heavy that I wash it by itself. That does not deter Onyx. Every time I turn my back she has carried that throw rug off and shook it. So far it is in one piece. I have complained vigorously about her exerting herself by taking it outside and shaking it. My protests have not daunted her enthusiasm for her latest chore.

I've never had so much help from a dog before.

### ROYAL HECHT AND GSDC OF ST. LOUIS AWARDS

The Royal Hecht Awards were set up several years ago by our club in honor of a past member. Our club also honors all titles earned throughout the year by club members' dogs. Awarded are the following AKC titles:

Companion Dog (CD), Companion Dog Excellent (CDX), Utility Dog (UD), Tracking (TD), and Champion (CH.).

We also honor a Parent Club title, Register Of Merit (POM). The ROM is won by a dog or bitch on producing ability alone. Simply, it means they must produce Champions and major point winning progeny. These progeny add points to their sires and dams when working in obedience as well as in conformation.

ROYAL HECHT AWARD RULES AND REGULATIONS: The following are the requirements which must be met to compete for the Royal Hecht Awards as set forth by the German Shepherd Dog Club of St. Louis, Inc. Points toward the Royal Hecht Awards will be tatalled at the end of the year and the dog with the highest score is awarded the trophy.

Yuor dog must be AKC registered, whelped in the United States or Canada, six months of age or older, points must be earned from AKC liscensed Shows, and you must be a member in good standing of the German Shepherd Dog Club of St. Louis, Inc.

ROYAL HECHT BRED BY EXHIBITOR AWARD: You must be the breeder and owner or coowner. You or a member of your immediate family or co-owner must handle the
dog only. (Immediate family = father, mother, sister, brother, wife, husband,
son, or daughter.) Breeder / owner, or co-owner must be a member in good standing.
Points toward the Royal Hecht Bred By Award will be awarded in proportion to the
competition entered in each individual class. There is no restriction as to the
number of dogs. NOTE:All entries count, not just those who show.

ROYAL HECHT BEST PUPPY AWAPD: You must be the owner or co-owner. Owner or co-owner must be a member in good standing. Points toward the Royal Hecht Best Puppy Award will be awarded in proportion to the competition entered in each individual class (THE PUPPY CLASSES ONLY). There is no restriction as to the number of dogs. NOTE: All entries count, not just those who show.

ROYAL HECHT OBEDIENCE AWARDS: The Royal Hecht Novice Obedience Award will be awarded to the dog with the highest combination of three scores in the Novice classes in a calendar year. The Royal Hecht Advanced Obedience Award will be awarded to the dog with the highest combination of three scores in the Open and or Utility classes in a calendar year. Five points may be added to the total upon the completion of any advanced title. (CDX, UD, TD).

ROYAL HECHT DUAL ACHEIVEMENT AWARD: The Royal Hecht Dual Acheivement Award will be to the dog with the highest score. The score will be based on the number of dogs defeated while placing in any regular class (as in the Bred By Award) plus the total of three qualifying scores in any regular obedience class in a calendar year.

The club also awards title winners: CD, CDX, UD, TD, or CH., Rom, Select, Top Winning dog, Review System.

NOTE: According to records, in 1979, the club also recognized the following titles: AD, Sch.H.I, II, & III. VB, and in 1983 we awarded for TT (Temperment Tested) and in 1985 for the TC (Temperment Certified). Then in 1986, we recognized the BH (Same as VB)., and gave SPECIAL AWARDS for GSDCA Hero Dogs, And for dogs who placed in international Schutzhund Competition.

Proposed clarifications, additions, and revisions Re:

- Under the rules and regulations section: delete "whelped in the United States or Canada"; delete "points must be earned from AKC licensed Shows"
- 2. Add: Titles from nationally and internationally recognized organizations (e.g., AKC, CKC, GSDCA, ATTS, SV, USA, DVG, etc.) will be considered.
- 3. Add: Titles will be recognized if the owner was a member of the GSDCSL at the time the title was earned.
- Under the obedience section: Novice Obedience Award this award will be based on the three official legs for the degree not just any combination of three scores; delete the "calendar year" restriction for this award. Advanced Obedience Award change the last sentence to read "If the scores from the three legs of a newly earned advanced title are used for this award, 5 points will be added to their total and the calendar year restriction waived"
- Standardization of plaque size for specific titles: Four sizes of plaques have been awarded (small, medium, large, and extra large).

BH/WH\*/AD Bred by Exhibitor Award CD

HIC (when approved) TD

Medium Plaques will be awarded for the following titles:

Futurity/Maturity Victor/Victrix

Large Plaques will be awarded for the following titles:

Top Winning Dog, Review System CH Select CH

SchH II & III International CH UD

The club would reserve the right to make special awards to unusual cases and awards not usually considered.

- 6.) It is the responsibility of the dog's owner to contact the person responsible for the Royal Hecht Awards and provide the correct name, title earned, the date the title was officially awarded, and scores if applicable. The Chairperson is not required to make calls and inquiries about degrees, titles, etc.
- 7.) In order to be awarded a Royal Hecht Plaque, a member must meet the qualifications which would enable them to vote in the election of Officers in January (i.e., attendance requirements, work hour requirements, finacial requirements.) These requirements could be met by an associate member as well as a regular member. Under unusual and/or extraordinary circumstances, a member may petition the appointed committee to waive any of the above requirements.

### New AKC Obedience Regulations

DYAN W. HARPER

The AKC obedience regulations have been changed as anticipated. The new regulations were approved by the AKC Board of Directors and appeared in the October, 1988 issue of the Gazette. The new regulations will take effect on March 1, 1989 and will require some changes for our Spring Show and Trial. The new regulations are summarized and explained below:

### I. GENERAL REGULATIONS

### A. When You Can Enter Advanced Classes

A handler can <u>now</u> enter an advanced obedience class after having been informed by three different judges that the dog has qualified. Before you had to wait until you were officially notified by AKC.

However, once you have entered a dog in an advanced class, you can not show again in the lower class. For example, once you have "entered" in Open A you can not show in Novice, likewise, you can't show in Open A after you enter an Utility class.

### B. Hair Over Eyes

Any dog whose hair over its eyes interferes with its vision may have the hair over its eyes tied back with either a neutral colored rubber band or small plain barrette. (NOTE: This use to apply to only 4 specific small breeds)

### C. <u>High Combined Score</u>

The new regulations now require that a ribbon or rosette be given to the dog with the highest combined Open and Utility scores.

COLOR OF RIBBON: The dog with the highest combined score will receive a "Blue & Green" ribbon or rosette. (NOTE: Our club has previously given a green rosette for this award)

The High Combined award can only be given to a dog that earns "qualifying scores" in both Utility and Open B. (NOTE: In the past this requirement seems to have been met at our trials)

### D. When Highest Scoring Dog and High Combined Dog Ribbons and/or Prizes are awarded

Both shall be awarded after the announcement of final scores of the last Regular class. (NOTE: We have some-

times awarded our High Combined after Open B scores were announced and sometimes have awarded the highest scoring prize and ribbons after all classes have finished. We will now have to award these prizes and ribbons before Graduate Novice and Veterans Classes.)

(NOTE: If we have more than one obedience judge, we will have to designate a judge to conduct run-offs for the two above awards)

### E. Ring Conditions

Inside rings should be about  $40' \times 50'$ . (NOTE: The old rules said  $35' \times 50'$ ) The judge's table and chairs can't interfer with the dog and handler's performance in the ring.

### F. Rejudging

If a dog must be rejudged on any group excercise, it can now be done with the next group of the same class rather than immediately and by itself.

### G. Judge's Book, Score Sheets, and Announcement of scores

Since there will no longer be a "group excercise" for Utility, the Utility dogs' total scores must be entered immediately upon finishing their ring performance and the judge will inform the handler whether they have qualified before they leave the ring.

### H. Judge's Explanations

While judges are not required to explain their scoring, they are now encouraged to discuss their scoring after the judge's books are turned in.

### I. Leashes

The leash  $\underline{\text{must}}$  now be made fabric or leather. (NOTE: Before it said "may")

### J. Hands: Applies to all classes

In all classes a "heel free" excercise is performed. There are two ways to carry your hands.

- #1. Arms and hands shall "move" naturally at your sides.
- #2. The right arm and hand shall move naturally, while the left hand is held against and centered in front of the body at the waist with the left forearm carried against the body.

### K. Commands and Signals

There no longer are any restrictions about the signals for "downing" a dog. (NOTE: It used to be only a raised arm or the downswing of the arm)

An extra command and/or signal in any "non-principal" part of an excercise does not, in itself, constitute a failing score or zero.

- II. CHANGES FOR THE NOVICE CLASS (\* items also apply to Open & Utility)
  - \*A. "Halt" and "Turn" orders will only be given when the handler is moving at a Normal Pace.

### B. Stand for Examination

- The handler must wait until the judge orders him/her to remove the dog's leash.
- 2. The handler must stand with the dog in heel position after posing the dog and before leaving.
- It's now a failure if the dog "lies down" during the examination. (NOTE: Before it only said "Sits")

### \*C. Recall

- 1. Substitute the word "directly" for straight.
- Points will be deducted if a dog fails to come at a "brisk trot or gallop".
- 3. Finishes which are "not prompt or smart" will have points deducted.

### \*D. Group Excercises

Dogs which change position after the handler returns, but before the judge says "Excercise Finished" will now receive substantial deductions. (NOTE: This used to receive a minor deduction)

### III. CHANGES FOR THE OPEN CLASS (+ items also apply to Utility)

- A. The judge now must give a hand and/or arm signal to drop the dog. (NOTE: Before a judge could give a verbal order or designate a spot for you to down the dog)
- B. Retrieve on Flat (Nonwooden Dumbbells now Allowed)

A dumbbell may be made of one or more solid pieces of wood, or of a rigid or semi-rigid, firm, nontoxic, non-wooden material, similar in size, shape, color and

weight to a wooden dumbbell. Metal dumbbells are not permitted. (NOTE: This allows for some of the new plastic dumbbells to be used, but it still must be approved by the judge)

### +C. High Jump (Lowering the heights)

The jumps will be set  $1\frac{1}{4}$  times the height of the dog at the withers instead of the old  $1\frac{1}{2}$  times. Below are some of the heights that apply to our Shepherds.

Dog's Height	Jump Height	
20" to less than 21½"	26"	
21½" to less than 23"	28"	
23" to less than 24½"	30''	
24½" to less than 26½"	32''	
26½" to less than 28"	34''	
28" or more	36"	

(NOTE: This will drop the jump 6 inches for most Shepherds)

### +D. Hesitation or Reluctance to Jump (A penalty for the High Jump, Bar Jump & Broad Jump)

In Open and Utility a minor to substantial deduction shall be made for a dog that shows reluctance or hesitation to jump. (NOTE: The rules had not previously mentioned this)

### E. Broad Jump

The broad jump is still twice the height of the high jump which have been lowered.

Dog's Height	Jump Distance
20" to less than 21½"	52"
21½" to less than 23"	56"
23" to less than 24½"	60''
24½" to less than 26½"	64''
26½" to less than 28"	68''
28" or more	72''

(NOTE: Most Shepherds will be jumping 12 inches less)

### IV. CHANGES FOR UTILITY CLASS (This is the most changed class)

### A. <u>Utility Excercises</u>

The group stand is totally eliminated, and a Moving Stand and Examination is added.

The order for the excercises now is:

1.	Signal Excercise	40 points
	Scent Discrimination - Article No. 1	30 points
3.	Scent Discrimination - Article No. 2	30 points
4.	Directed Retrieve	30 points
5.	Moving Stand & Examination	30 points
6.	Directed Jumping	40 points

200 points

### B. Scent Discrimination (Changes in procedures & scoring)

- 1. The judge will ask "Are you ready?" before taking the first article from the handler and scoring now begins when the handler remits the first article.
- 2. Turning to face the articles: The handler can now turn either left or right. (NOTE: You had to turn right before) The handler will come to a halt facing the articles with the dog sitting in the heel position. (NOTE: Before you had the option of halting or sending the dog directly without stopping)
- Deductions will be made for the handler "not turning in place" and for the dog not going directly to the articles.

### C. Directed Retrieve

- 1. The handler must give a verbal command to retrieve (hand signals are now forbidden).
- 2. The handler must turn "in place" and face the designated glove without excessive motions.

### D. Moving Stand and Examination (The new excercise)

1. On orders from the judge, the dog and handler will move forward at a normal pace from the sitting-atheel position. After they have proceeded about 10 feet, the judge will order "Stand your dog". The handler without pausing will command and/or signal the dog to stand and continue forward 10-12 feet, and, on order from the judge halts and turns to face the dog. The judge will then approach the dog and examine the dog as in the novice class.

The judge will order the handler to "Call your dog to heel". The dog will briskly go directly into the heel position (no front).

2. Deductions are similar to those in heel free, novice stand for examination, and recall excercises. Additionally, deductions will be made if the handler changes his/her manner of walking or hesitates while commanding the dog to stand and for the dog not returning briskly and directly to the heel position.

#### V. O.T.CH. POINTS AND PLACEMENTS

In order to receive an OTCH a dog must have won three First Places under three judges "at all breed obedience trials, whether held separately or in conjunction with an all breed show". (NOTE: First Place wins at specialties won't count for this requirement although any OTCH points earned will count towards the needed 100 points).

#### VI. VETERANS CLASS

Dogs must be eight years old "on the date of the trial". (NOTE: Before they had to 8 by the closing of entries)

VII. ANOTHER REGULATION CHANGE WHICH WILL TAKE EFFECT JANUARY 1, 1990

Utility class must be divided into Utility A and Utility B. (NOTE: This won't affect us until the Spring 1990 Show and Trial)
