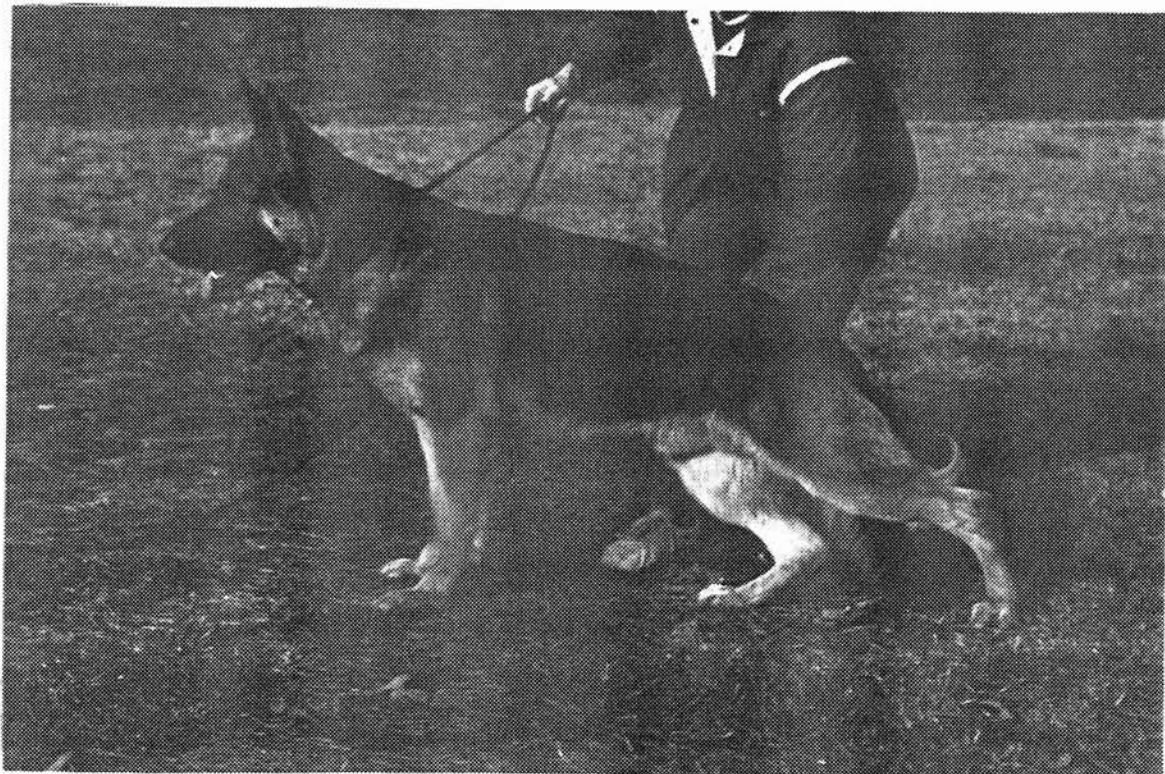

WHOSE IN CONTROL?

by Pam Teiber

It's been several years since I've climbed up on my soapbox, but once again I've been agitated to the point where I can't take any more!

This time my victims are Rabies Control officers. Im' sure I'll hear repercussions, but I must relate to all of you my experiences - past and present - with these people.

My first experience occurred while living in unincorporated St. Louis County. A large (extremeley large) Great Dane male obviously escaped from his yard and was wreaking havoc throughout our neighborhood. Trash cans were overturned, flowerbeds trampled, small dogs that were also out wandering (aren't some dog owners wonderful?) were chewed on or chased until this big guy lost interest or tired. After witnessing all of the above, I phoned St. Louis County Rabies Control and told them the exact location of this dog (on my front yard resting under a tree) and would they please send someone out to get him before the morning kindergarten children got off the bus. Now, get this, I was told by Rabies Control to "confine" the dog and they would send someone out as soon as they could! My response was "You mean you want me to try and catch this strange dog and snap on a lead and put him in my garage, basement, kennel, house or whatever and keep him until you can send out an officer to pick him up??!???" Their answer was simply "Yes, Ma'am". I replied with "There is no way in hell I am going to go out and try to tackle a strange dog that outweighed me by 30 pounds. Even if he is friendly (which he was not), why should I risk the chance of bringing parasites and/or disease into my residence where my healthy dogs live." Rabies Control again repeated "Confine the dog and we will pick it up". I slammed the phone down and did the only other thing I could think of to protect my neighbors and their children. I called the elementary school and explained the situation. They in turn, notified the bus drivers and contacted parents of the kindergarten children. Many

parents drove to the bus stop to pick up their kids. I don't know where the dog ended up. Perhaps he found his way home. I never saw him again.

That was seven years ago, and just as I thought it was safe to go out in the yard again - another ridiculous situation occurs.

I now reside in Jefferson County, known for it's share of rabies cases, stray animals and road kill. I must describe the area and people who live near me for you all to understand and appreciate my feelings, so here goes.

In our valley, there are five families. We occasionally see a stray or escaped dog, but they are usually on the run and don't hang out. The problem lies with some of the "back woods intelligence" a few of my neighbors possess, and as I soon discovered, rabies control officers here possess these same qualities. Of the five families that reside on our road, each house has a dog or dogs. In the 3½ years I have lived here with a minimum of 4 dogs, NEVER has one of my dogs left our property. Since we are not fenced, I have stood out in pouring rain, bitter cold scorching heat, night and day and pleaded the same four words "HURRY UP -GO POTTY!" I buy my kennel license yearly, have my dogs up to date on vaccinations, obedience train each of them and do not allow constant barking. But, my neighbors think I'm the bitch of the valley because of my stand on being a good dog neighbor! "DAWGS OUGHTA BE ABLE TO BE FREE!" is the cry of my neighbors.

House #1 has a 14 year old beagle male who has had numerous encounters with other dogs and wild animals. This dog is never taken to the vet and is allowed to run, sometimes with as many as 10 or so ticks stuck to his eyelids. Several years ago he wandered up into our yard at night, tempted by Tracy in heat. I made my 9 p.m. outing with Caesar that night and Caesar chewed him up and spit him out.

Frantically, I called House #1 and told them that their dog was just attacked in my yard and to please check on him. I also offered first aid and antibiotics, etc. I never heard back from House #1, but two days later saw the dog on the road, gaping neck wounds and all, heading down his favorite path.

House #2 has 3 dogs. A Golden Retriever bitch who has had one purebred litter and one litter by House #4's pit bull terrier, a 14 year old black Lab bitch with cauliflower ears from numerous infections and a Basset Hound bitch who was run over by its owner in a 4X4 3/4 ton pickup and survived. I was called when that happened and advised on shock and movement of the injured dog to the vet. \$600 later she was home and hit by another car and was killed. They found her body when House #4's pit bull terrier male dragged her remains up on their porch. House #2 is now going into breeding Bassets. Their \$300 pet shop stud puppy was recently run over by the Union Electric meter reader and had to be euthanized. They are in the process of suing UE.

House #3 is me.

House #4, as I mentioned before, has a pit bull terrier dog which was adopted from the Jefferson County Animal Shelter at approximately one year of age. These people adopted the dog and brought it home for their 2 yr and 4 yr old boys to play with!! This dog is spooky around strangers and I've heard sounds of the owner literally beating this poor animal for something the owner felt the dog did wrong. (Their idea of training). This dog made his appearance in my yard last fall when I had a litter of 5 week old Shepherd pups outside playing. Our whole family was out enjoying the weather and the babies, when suddenly I looked up and saw this dog charging the pups with the look of "Kill the prey" in his eyes. I screamed NO and Bob threw a wooden ball bat towards him. This managed to scare him off home. I called House #4 to inform them of what their dog had just attempted - no one home.

Well, you guessed it, my next call was to Rabies Control. I WAS TOLD TO CONFINED THE DOG AND WHEN AN OFFICER WAS AVAILABLE THEY WOULD SEND HIM OUT!!!!!!!!!!

I then asked them to come out and talk to the owners and enforce the leash law. Their reply was to shoot the dog if he comes on my property acting dangerously! I explained to rabies control that knowing how "backwoods" my neighbor is, that if I shot his dog, I could guarantee that I would come home from work some day and find every one of my dogs dead in their kennels. The reply I received just floored me, it was, and I quote, "Well, you certainly have a problem don't you?"

Yessiree, I'm the bitch of the valley!!!

Don't get me wrong, I'm against breed specific laws.

However, if Rabies Control cannot effectively enforce a simple leash law or help someone with this type of situation, why worry about these breed specific laws??

My question - Whose in control??

My answer - NO ONE!

July 1, 1988, CHAIRMEN REPORTS FOR REGIONAL CLUBS

1. A certification program to test the instincts for the above mentioned herding skills. This will include the necessary forms for scoring.
2. A program for the training and certification of Herding instinct Testers. This will also include the necessary forms for implementation.

The following rules and requirements will be submitted to the Herding Committee as soon as it is formed and approved. Either this or a revised version will be submitted to the next board meeting for approval.

3. Tests for Herding Instinct Certificates may be held at any German Shepherd Dog Club function, including local or national clubs, at events such as shows, meetings, matches, etc., or as a separate function. Tests will be held in conjunction with any other working dog group providing that the local or national club acts as co-sponsor.
4. Tests may be held on sheep or cattle with a minimum of three (3) head of stock per dog.
5. Testers must be approved prior to the test by the Herding Chairperson. (Separate sheet for certification of Testers).
6. Tests are run on a "pass", "not pass" system, and the decision of the tester on that day shall not be subject to dispute.
7. Each dog shall be allowed a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes in each test to show instinct.
8. All dogs that are tested will have forms filled out in full by appropriate parties and one copy shall remain with the owner. The host club shall submit all other copies of the form to the Herding Chairperson.
9. Dogs that pass the herding certificate test shall be issued a Herding Instinct Certificate by the German Shepherd Dog Club of America and shall be entitled to use the initials "H.I.C." (Herding Instinct Certificate) after the dog's name.
10. Sponsoring clubs shall request test forms and approval from the Herding Chairperson at least 30 days before the date of the test.
11. It shall be the duty of the club representative or sponsoring individual to see that all forms are completed before submission to the Herding Chairperson

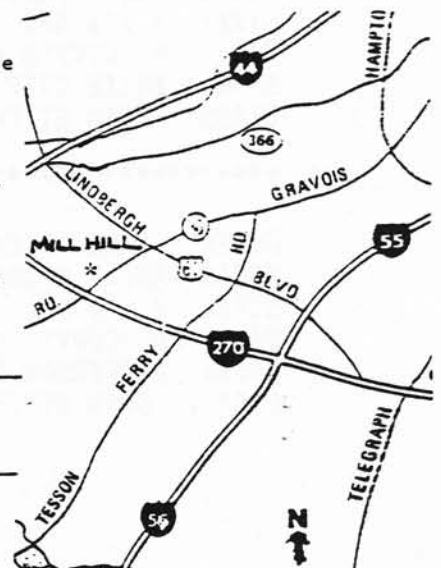

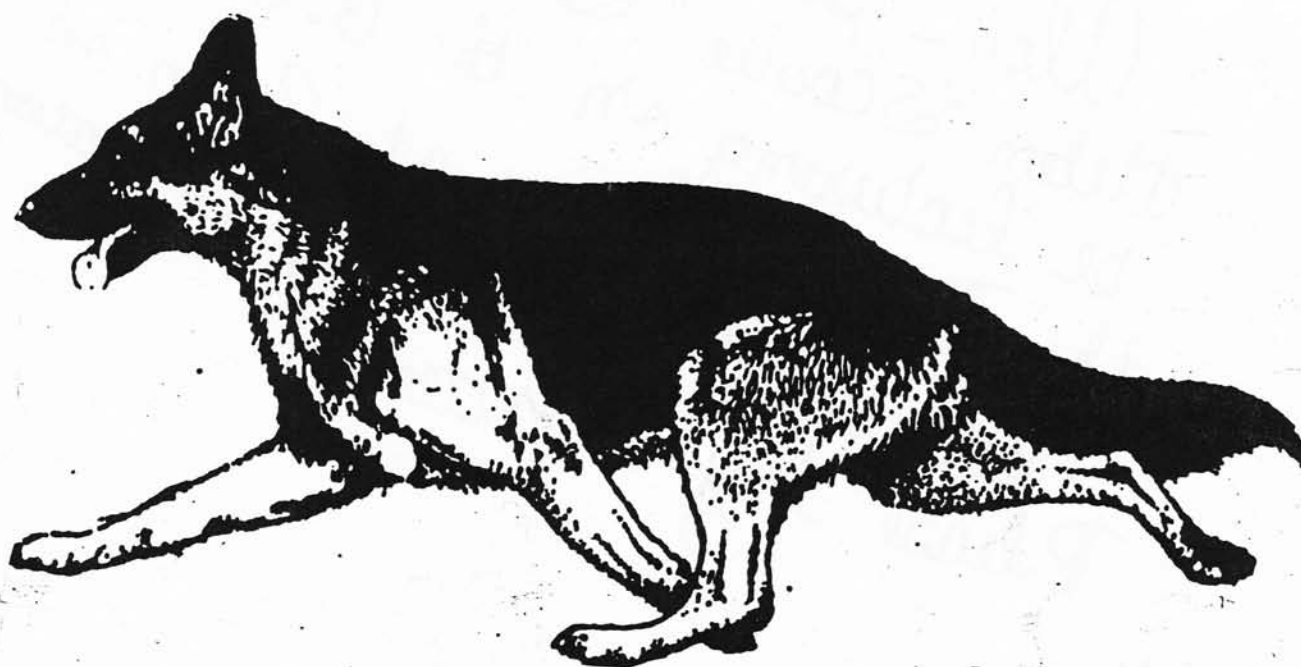
